

## 30,000 Visitors to Begin Boston Trek Soon

The 47th annual convention of the Loyal Order of Moose, and its auxiliary, the Women of the Moose, will be held in Boston from June 30 to July 7.

Thousands of delegates and their families from all sections of the country will come here for the convention activities and trips to New England's shore and mountain resorts.
