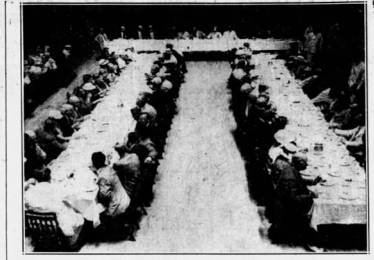
MOOSE INSTAL NEW OFFICERS
