The deadline to submit your nominee will be June 30, 2023. The HOC committee will read through all nominations and submit their vote to determine the most deserving member for this award. We will notify the Lodge by Aug 1st so they have time to make arrangements for their member to be at the dinner Saturday night at the August Convention.
