SENATOR DAVIS TO SPEAK AT MOOSE CONFERENCE

Sessions in Providence Planned to Organize Permanent N. E. Association

At the Loyal Order of Moose conference to be held in Providence August 21-22-23 for the purpose of organizing a permanent New England Association, Senator James J. Davis of Pennsylvania, who is Pilgrim governor and head of the Moose fraternity, will be the principal speaker. It is expected that more than 200 lodges and 100 women's chapters will be represented at the conference, the first of its kind to be attempted by the order in New England. Other invited speakers are United States Senators Jesse H. Metcalf and Peter G. Gerry and Mrs. Elsie Robinson, newspaperwoman.

The Pilgrim Governor Council, which is a governing body of the national organization, will be present for the first meetings, which will be held in the Crown Hotel, August 21-22. Sunday, August 23, the conference will assemble at the Plantations Club for competitive drills and ritualistic contests.

Regional Director W. Lee Provost of Chicago is in charge of a membership drive for the Providence Lodge, which has launched a campaign for 2,500 members, and plans to erect a new home in Providence.

The committee in charge of the conference has Frank Labelle of Watertown, Mass., as chairman; J. J. McDermott, secretary of the Providence Lodge, as vice chairman; and James E. Kennedy, treasurer.
