Attendance at a WOTM Officers Training Class during the year you are serving as Senior Regent, Junior Past Regent, and Treasurer is one of the requirements to achieve personal honors – i.e., Golden Gavel, College of Regents, and Star Degree. Note: Senior Regent/Junior Past Regents should plan to attend both years they are serving in these positions as one of the requirements to first earn the Golden Gavel and then, the College of Regents degree (all personal requirements must have been met BOTH years of service as Senior Regent and Junior Past Regent). ALL OTHER Chapter officers and Chairmen are encouraged to attend the training as well as any interested Chapter or Lodge members. Attendance would be especially helpful to new officers.

Please let the Hostess Chapter or the Session Leader know that you will be attending the class so that they can plan lunch and seating arrangements. The fee to attend the Training Session is \$10.00 per coworker which will be collected at the class. An additional, nominal fee may be charged by the hostess chapter to help cover the cost of lunch.

All attendees should come to the session prepared. Please bring your membership ID card, WOTM Officers Handbook and WOTM General Laws.
